

Operations Committee Roles and Responsibilities

ROLES:

The Operations Committee ensures the Mid-North Food Pantry operates efficiently, safely, and in alignment with best practices and regulatory requirements. The committee provides guidance on operational processes, compliance, and service delivery to ensure high-quality support for those we serve.

The committee focuses on:

- Establishing and maintaining best practices for pantry operations
- Ensuring compliance with TEFAP (The Emergency Food Assistance Program) and other applicable guidelines
- Evaluating and improving day-to-day pantry processes, including food distribution, storage, and volunteer coordination
- Advising on safety and quality standards for food handling and delivery
- Supporting strategic decisions around operational growth and efficiency

Note: While experience in pantry operations, food delivery, or food services is helpful, it is not a requirement. Members with a passion for improving service delivery and operational excellence are encouraged to join.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Work with the Executive Director and staff to evaluate and improve operational processes.
- 2. Ensure compliance with TEFAP and other local, state, and federal regulations related to food safety and distribution.
- 3. Provide recommendations for training volunteers and staff on safety and operational protocols.
- 4. Assist in implementing and reviewing operational policies and procedures to enhance efficiency and effectiveness.
- 5. Participate in periodic assessments of pantry facilities and operations to identify areas for improvement.
- 6. Offer insights and strategies to support the pantry's capacity to meet increasing demand.
- 7. Provide expertise or connections related to food services, logistics, or compliance when applicable.

COMMITMENTS:

- 1. Attend at least 80% of Operations Committee meetings.
- Dedicate approximately 2–4 hours per month, including meetings, assessments, and related tasks.
- 3. Support specific projects or initiatives based on individual skills and expertise.
- 4. Collaborate with staff partners and other committee members to address immediate and long-term operational needs.
